Dear Parent/Guardian:

The State of New Jersey now requires all students born after January 1, 1997 **and** 11 years of age entering Grade 6 to receive a booster dose of Diptheria, Tetanus and Pertussis (Tdap) vaccine as well as one dose of Meningococcal vaccine (N.J.S.A. 18A:40-21.2).

Documentation of these two immunizations from your primary care provider must be provided to your elementary school nurse by the end of the school year. These are required before entering Grade 6 in September with the exception of those students who have not turned 11 years of age by the completion of school in June. Therefore, upon turning 11 years old, documentation of these two immunizations from your primary care provider must be provided to your middle school nurse. Students will be **excluded from school in September** if they do not get the required vaccines.
